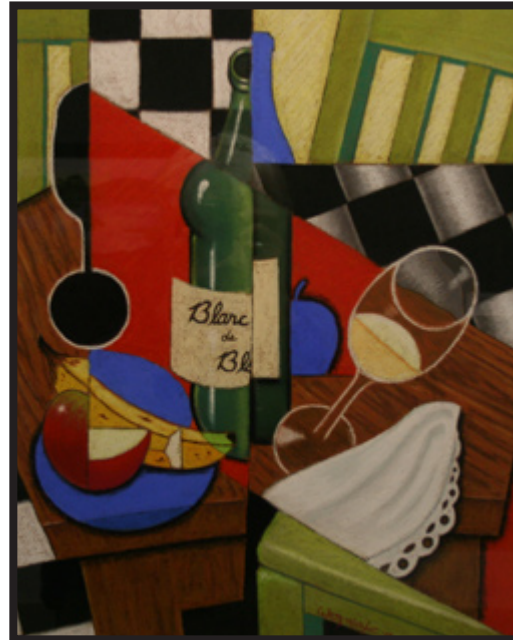

Presenting Artist for February's Program

John's first art education occurred while he was still an elementary school student when he attended Saturday art classes at the Samuel S. Fleisher Art Memorial in Philadelphia. Drawing played a major part in his career as an architect for over 46 years. He typically produced renderings of building projects in pen and ink with color often added with designer markers. In addition to his professional licensing in six states and membership in the American Institute of Architects, John was certified by the National Council of Architectural Boards.

John retired from architectural practice to the mountains of western North Carolina in Hendersonville in 2005 and studied watercolor painting with a number of nationally-known watercolorists. He is a Signature Member of the Watercolor Society of North Carolina and serves on their Board of Directors. He is also a member of the Southern Watercolor Society, the Alabama Watercolor Society and the Art League of Henderson County. He is a life-member of the Whiskey Painters of America.

John is a partner in the Asheville Gallery of Art, Ltd. and is also represented by Wickwire Fine Art/Folk Art, Hendersonville, NC and Gallery Alta Vista in Valle Crucis, NC. John's work has been juried into numerous shows and has been the recipient of a number of awards.

GALLERY HANGING RULES

CHANGE OUT/HANGING DAYS:

Friday, February 10, 2012 - 9:00 - 9:30 A.M.

Friday, March 9, 2012 - 9:00 - 9:30 A.M.

MEMBERSHIP MUST BE CURRENT TO HANG

PROCEDURE CHANGE for registering your paintings. **SIGNS AT EACH TABLE WILL GUIDE YOU THROUGH THE PROCESS...**

- 1) All paintings **MUST BE** original work, conceived & executed by the Artist.
- 2) The back of each painting must include Artist **NAME, TITLE OF PAINTING, MEDIA, PRICE & PHONE NUMBER.**
- 3) Maximum dimensions, including frame, must not exceed 44”X32”. All paintings over ½ sheet must use acrylic, not glass.
- 4) All submissions must be framed and securely wired, with clear glass (where applicable). For the safety of paintings, saw-tooth hangers must **NOT** be used. Paintings with defective frames will be rejected.
- 5) Hanging fee for 1-2 paintings (as space allows) is \$3.00. Separate fee of \$3.00 for exhibits in the big room, such as themed shows.
- 6) All artwork must be hung for the entire show (until next hanging date) unless a painting is sold & removed from the Gallery, in which case, another painting, approximately the same size, should replace it for the remainder of the show.
- 7) **ARTIST OF THE MONTH PAINTINGS** may be exhibited the following year, but will not be eligible for a similar award.
